

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#### **SCHEDULE III**

### FINENESS MARK SURROUNDS IN MANUFACTURERS' OR SPONSORS' HALLMARKS AUTHORISED BY THE CONSUL

1. The surround specific to each precious metal referred to in paragraph (c) of regulation 6 and which must surround the standards of fineness of the precious metals referred to in Schedule II are indicated below:-



- 2. The standard of fineness must be indicated within these surrounds along the axis of the dashes.
- 3. The imprint of these surrounds must be immediately preceded by an adjacent appropriate manufacturer's or sponsor's mark set in an independent surround.
